Diabetes Insulin Pump and CGM Supply Vendors:

Diabetes supplies for insulin pump and continuous glucose-monitoring (CGM) devices are processed according to the *medical portion of the health plan* as DME (Durable Medical Equipment), not pharmacy. Purchases of DME apply to the applicable *Deductible and Co-insurance* that is in effect at the time of the purchase.

Initial purchase of either an insulin pump or the continuous glucose-monitoring (CGM) device needs to be preauthorized with UMR, more information is available by calling (800)826-9781 or visiting the UMR website at <u>www.UMR.com</u>.
